Statement of Bible College Resources to be provided by HOJ-ICBS HOJ-ICBS will provide the indigenous Bible/Ministry Training <u>College</u>

- 1. <u>School Initiation and Development Guidelines</u>.
- 2. <u>Curriculum</u>: Copyright free Bible College curriculum for Associate Degree Program, Diploma Certificate and 6-month Continuing Education Certificate Programs, with 'Non-Copyright Free' Bachelor of Divinity Curriculum.

Properties of Curriculum:

- A. Copyright Free: Course books and materials may be photocopied by the school administration as often as desired at their own cost. There is no limit to number of copies that can be made.
- B. Content of curriculum is books and teachings of HOJ-ICBS staff and other reputable Christian leaders who have released copyright privileges to their materials.
- C. This may also include other communication mediums such as CD, videotape, DVD, USB memory device, etc.
- D. Teaching outlines and study guides as appropriate to specific courses.
- E. Proposed student examinations: currently under development by HOJ-ICBS staff. Some examinations may be developed by Bible College personnel with guidelines provided by HOJ-ICBS administrative staff.
- 3. <u>Curriculum updates</u>: Release of new materials for required curriculum or elective courses as obtained or developed by HOJ-ICBS staff for individual school requests:
 - A. Target school may make specific requests to HOJ-ICBS staff according to their perceived needs.
 - B. HOJ-ICBS staff will attempt to obtain or develop such materials as reasonable.
 - C. Local indigenous instructors may provide their own teachings as part of the curriculum.

4. Financial resources:

- A. Curriculum will be provided free of charge to the member Bible Colleges and their representatives.
- B. A digital copy of each written course item will be provided.
- C. In most cases one copy of durable items such as USB memory device.
- D. HOJ-ICBS's ability to release such materials free of charge will depend upon financial donors made up primarily from U.S. supporters of HOJ-ICBS.
- E. Donors for provision of the curriculum materials are mobilized primarily by prayer: Ongoing prayer will be the motivating and mobilizing factor for

ongoing financial needs of providing and mailing curriculum materials by HOJ-ICBS, and for God's provision for resources needed by the target school.

- F. Prayer for wisdom, anointing and provision might be made by:
 - a. HOJGI and HOJ-ICBS oversight team and staff members.
 - b. HOJ prayer team mailing list participants.
 - c. Target area Church fellowship sponsoring the Target school.
 - d. Target school administrative faculty and students.
 - e. Other sources mobilized by HOJGI, HOJ-ICBS, Church fellowships sponsoring the Target Bible College, or by the Target Bible College.
- G. It is expected that an indigenous parent Church fellowship would serve as a sponsoring agent for the Bible and ministry training college and contribute to its resources.
- 5. <u>Apostolic Oversight</u>: Relational oversight by partnership with HOJGI and HOJ-ICBS administrative staff ongoing by means of:
 - A. Long distance communications through post, e-mail, phone, Skype.
 - B. Potential for regular on-site visitation by HOJGI or HOJ-ICBS representatives.

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
